WHAT IS COACHING?

CPC offers attendees the unique opportunity to bring a specific question or issue to a personal, one-on-one, 30-minute conversation with a veteran ministry leader.

- CPC Coaches are kingdom-minded leaders with a desire to use their extensive experience to serve the Children's Ministry community.
- CPC Coaches go through an interview process and are trained through an online course developed and led by INCM staff.
- INCM has adopted the CCNI Christian Coaching Definition: "Coaching is a professional relationship focused on empowering a person or group to effect change, create new awareness, move into action and step into abundant Christian life..."
- The primary distinction of Christian coaching is based on the foundational belief that God seeks active involvement in the lives of humans; those created in His very image.

"Stated concisely, coaching is the art and practice of enabling individuals and groups to move from where they are to where they want to be." - Dr. Gary R. Collins

The INCM/CPC coaching philosophy is pulled from **Proverbs 20:5 (ESV):**
"The purpose of a man's heart is like deep waters, but a man of understanding draws them out."

WHO CAN APPLY?

If you are a believer in Jesus Christ, a veteran ministry leader, with at **least 10 years of ministry experience**, are planning to attend CPC27, and are willing and able to volunteer to Coach a ministry leader, during one or more appointment times at CPC, **you are welcome to apply!**

REQUIREMENTS TO COACH AT CPC:

- Coaching is done on a volunteer basis by leaders who have registered for CPC. CPC ticket arrangements are the responsibility of each Coach. All Coaches must be registered for CPC27, no later than October 30, 2026.
- To coach at CPC, you must be a follower of Jesus Christ and pursuing a transformational relationship with the Lord. Coaches are also veteran ministry leaders, with 10+ years experience.
- New coaches will be required to participate in a short video interview with 1-2 leaders on the INCM team, and will be asked to submit a reference with contact information. New coaches and coaches who have not been on the CPC Coaching Team for 2 or more years, will be required to complete a short, online training by October 30.
